A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COATESVILLE, CHESTER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, RECOGNIZING RESIDENT JOHN PAWLOWSKI FOR HIS EFFORTS IN BEAUTIFYING THE CITY AND IN PARTICULAR FOR HIS VISION IN ACQUIRING THE GAZEBOS AND OTHER IMPROVEMENTS AT THE RIVER WALK

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council for the City of Coatesville, that the City expressly recognizes the many years of selfless sacrifice of John Pawlowski on behalf of the City and in particular his improvements at the City's River Walk, and in recognition thereof, hereby officially approves the purchase and installation of a plaque or plaques on the Gazebos in the City's River Walk with words recognizing the achievements of John Pawloski and stating as follows:

"In recognition of the extraordinary efforts of John Pawlowski to benefit the City of Coatesville and the City's River Walk, this Gazebo is dedicated to John Pawlowski, without whose efforts this Gazebo would not be here for the use of City residents"
