**A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COATESVILLE,  
CHESTER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, STATING ITS POSITION ON EQUALITY  
AND HUMAN RIGHTS.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Coatesville ("City") is a Third Class City operating by means of a home rule charter; and

**WHEREAS**, The City is a progressive community grounded in the concept that all individuals are entitled to fundamental equality and equality of opportunity; and

**WHEREAS**, the City rejects prejudicial or discriminatory treatment of any person whether a resident or visitor; and

**WHEREAS**, the City strives to apply a standard of equitable practices and fair treatment towards every individual; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of Coatesville, that it is the City of Coatesville's position:



That all individuals in the City of Coatesville, whether resident or visitor, should be treated with equality and in recognition of their human rights, without regard to their actual or perceived race, color, age, religious creed, ancestry, sex, national origin, disability, sexual orientation, gender identity or gender expression.
